INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A CIVIL SUIT (SMALL CLAIMS ACTION) (Please Read Carefully)

- 1. We MUST have the Plaintiff's (the individual(s) bringing the lawsuit) name, mailing address and telephone number.
- 2. We MUST have the Defendant(s)'s (the individual/business being sued) name and physical address. We WILL NOT accept a post office box as an address.
- 3. It is the Plaintiff's responsibility to find the Defendant's address, the Court cannot and will not assist the Plaintiff in locating the Defendant. Please make sure the address is in **PICKENS** County before filing.
- 4. Complete the Attached Form including monies being sought, the court cost if requesting the Defendant be responsible for that sum and give a brief and accurate description of the claim.
- 5. The Filing MUST be verified by a signature, dated, and notarized; or if filing in person, must be sworn to and verified by a Judge, Clerk, or Deputy Clerk.
- 6. **\$106.00** is due at the time of filing. There is an additional cost of **\$50.00** for each person being sued, i.e., if the Plaintiff is suing 2 people, it would be **\$156.00** to file.
- 7. A Civil Suit **MUST** be personally or notoriously served by the Sheriff's Office. Our office will mail you a copy of the Sheriff's service once received, but you're welcome to call our office to inquire if service has been completed.
- 8. The Defendant(s) will have thirty (30) days after service to file an answer before the case goes into Default. However, the Defendant has an additional fifteen (15) days to open the default by filing an answer and paying all court costs. No Answer may be filed after forty-five (45) days.
- 9. A Default Judgment WILL NOT be issued automatically. The Plaintiff may request a Default Judgment in writing supported by the appropriate documents after forty-five days, provided no answer was filed by the Defendant. Our website provides the form needed under the Magistrate Court Civil Forms tab, <u>www.pickensgacourts.org</u>.
- 10. If an answer is filed by the Defendant, the Court will schedule a hearing date, a copy of the answer and hearing notice will be mailed to the address provided at the time of filing.
- 11. Should the Plaintiff no longer wish to proceed with the suit for any reason, a written request to dismiss the case will need to be submitted to our Office.
- 12. Employees of the Magistrate Court of Pickens County, including Judges themselves, are prohibited by law from providing legal advice (legal advice includes defining terms) at any time during your contact with the Court. If you have questions about your legal rights, legal remedies available to you, what legal documents to file, or how to present evidence at a hearing, you must contact an attorney or conduct research on your own.
